

JACK ALLEN CUP 'Race' to RAMSGATE - Sat 24th MAY

This cup will be awarded to the boat with the fastest corrected time between the Pollard Spit buoy, and crossing the finish line which is latitude 51degrees 20'.00 North (which is about a half-mile north of the dredged channel into Ramsgate).

So please take your times at these two points. No use of engines is allowed unless needed for an emergency – in which case please make a note of the engine run-time and the circumstances.

There is no fixed start time, but your time of passing the Pollard Spit buoy must be between 0500 and 1000 hours. So you can make a decision about likely wind later, versus getting a lift from the tide most of the way, or having breakfast first!

Give all details to me on 'Cornsilk' over the weekend. I will work out the results and my decision will be final (if anyone wants to argue with that, they can organise it instead 😊 😊).
